Jessica is trained in the Animal Normalization Technique with 6 years' experience. Animal Normalization Therapy© (ANT) is defined as "a unique combination of manual therapy techniques derived from the principles of osteopathy with its main goal to "normalize" vascular, lymphatic, neurological, and facial dysfunctions in the body".
